Formula 1

The top level of single-seater racing. "Formula" refers to the rules all cars must follow. Each season includes multiple Grand Prix held worldwide on circuits and closed roads.



Formula 2

A junior series supporting F1 events. All teams use the same chassis, engine, and tires to highlight driver skill and keep racing affordable.



FIA

Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile – the governing body that licenses and regulates Formula 1, Formula 2, WRC, WEC, Formula E, and other series.

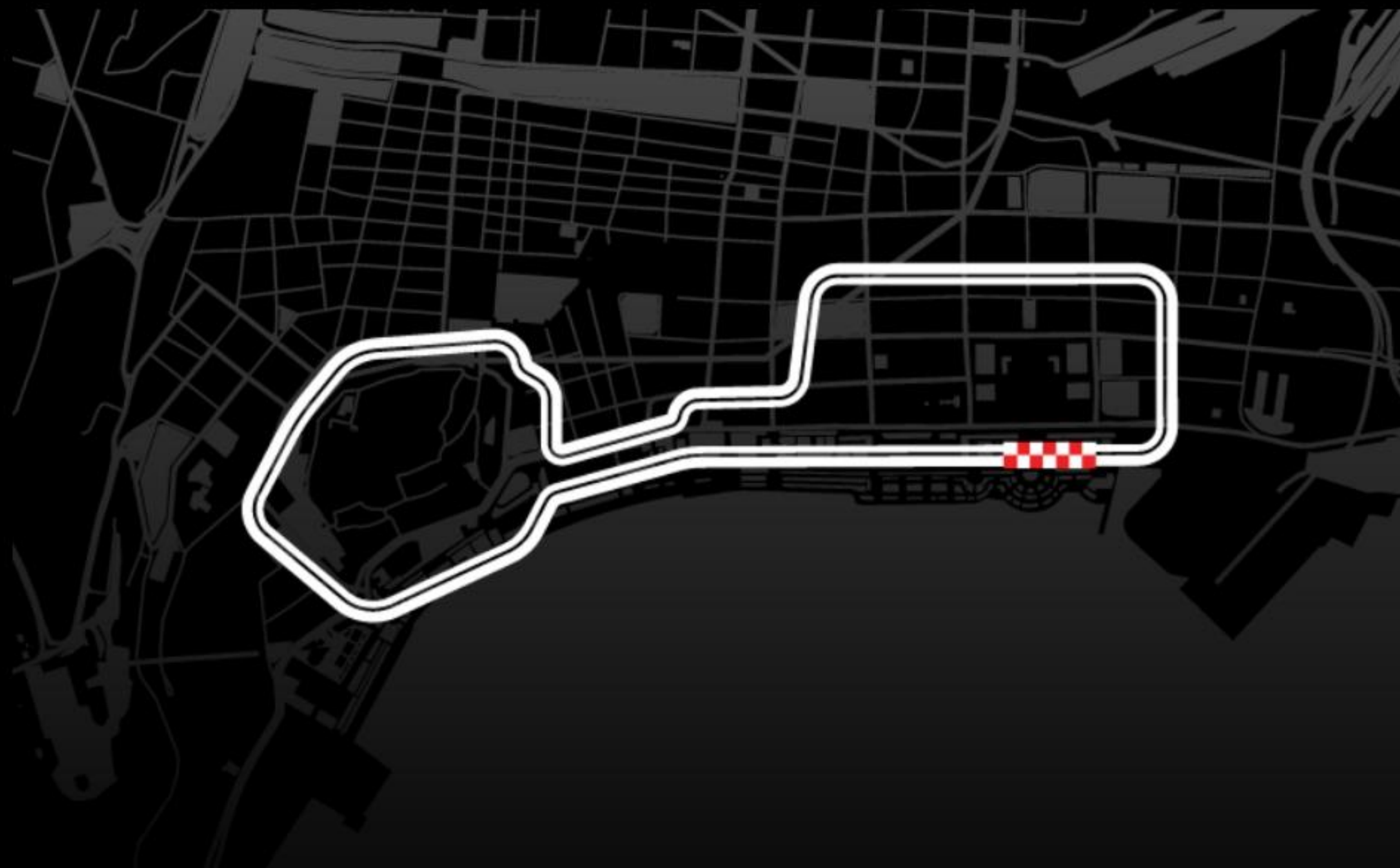

WHO IS A SCRUTINEER?

Is a person who observes any process which requires rigorous oversight

WHY ARE WE THERE?

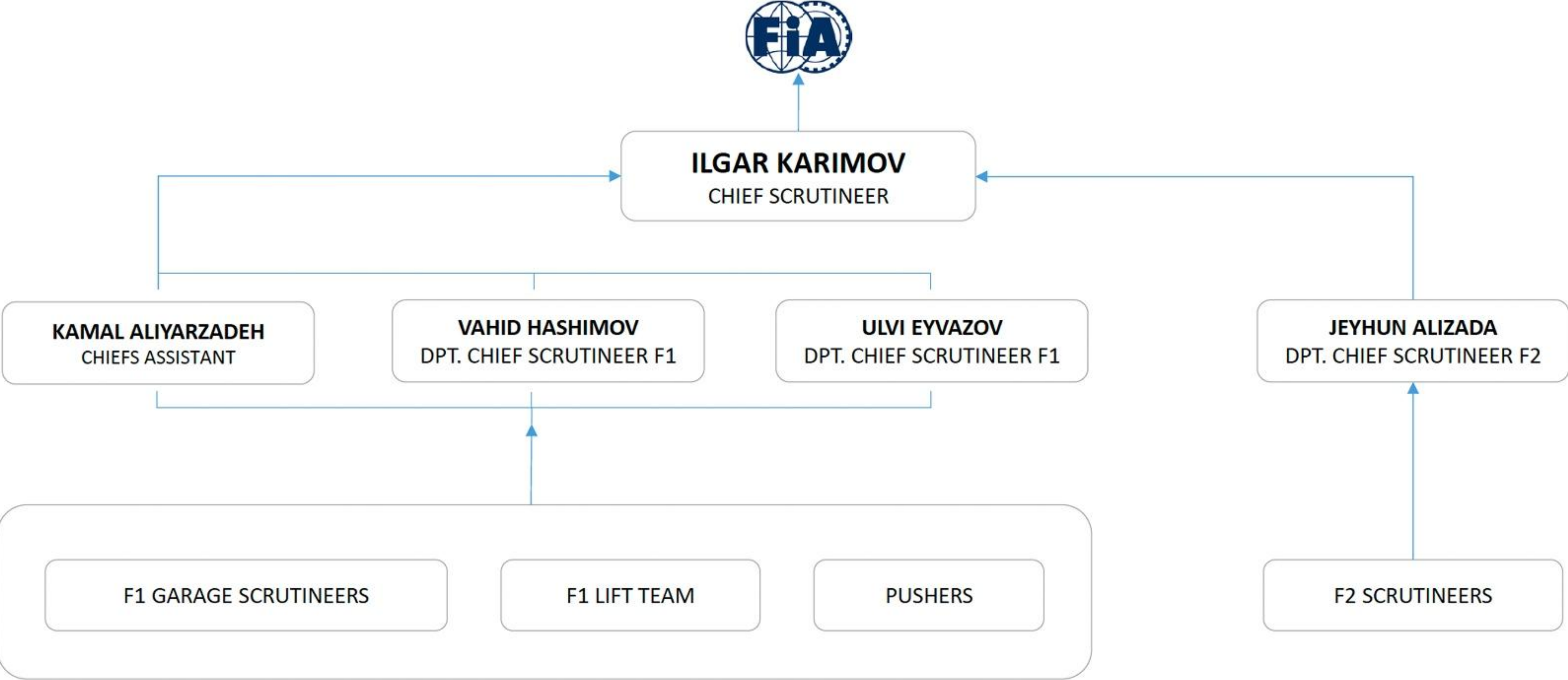
Racing series have a set of technical regulations to which the cars, bikes or other vehicles must conform

WHAT DO WE DO?

The main responsibility of Scrutineers is to perform inspections of race cars before, during and after every main racing event

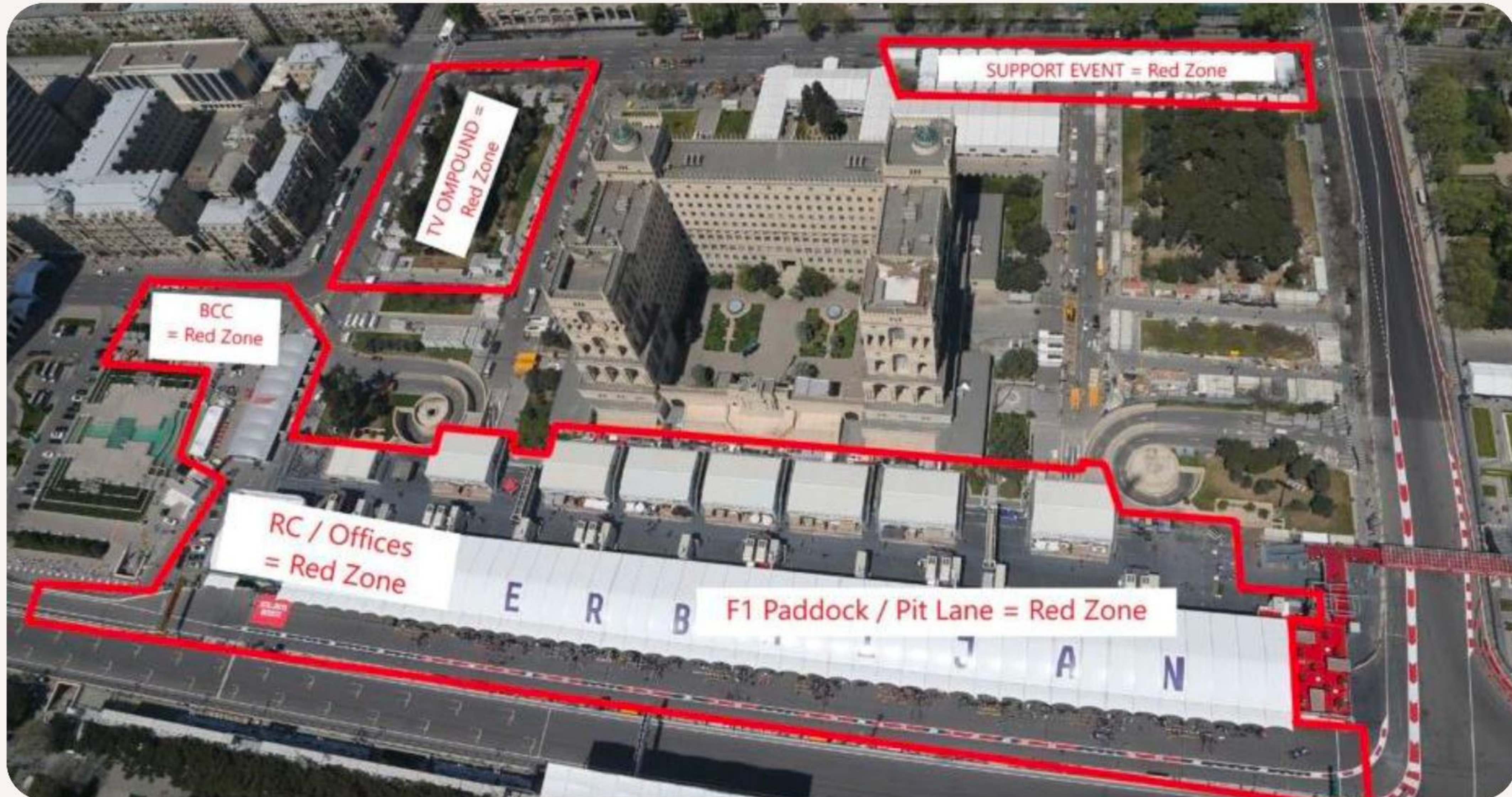

FORMULA 1 SCHEDULE

FREE PRACTICE

During these sessions teams are allowed to release their cars on track in order to:

- Check if all systems of cars are working
- Let drivers get familiar with the track
- Adjust the cars based on drivers feedback

QUALIFYING

This session determines starting position for each car

During this session, the car with the fastest lap time will start from 1st place (Pole Position)

During this session, the car with the fastest lap time will start from 1st place (Pole Position)

RACE

After “Lights out and away we go” we’ll watch worlds biggest Motorsport event!

FREE PRACTICE

2 official 1-hour sessions

Teams are free to adjust or modify their cars

SCRUTINEERS IN GARAGES

2 Scrutineers are assigned to each team

One Garage Scrutineer per car: the job is to monitor all car related processes of the car

ONE TEAM

You must rely and respect your teammate

Teamwork makes dreamwork

FREE PRACTICE 3

1 official 1-hour session Teams are free to adjust or modify their cars

QUALIFYING

Q1

All cars leave the garages

At the end of the session TOP 15 drivers proceed to Q2

LAST 5 cars are deemed to PARC FERME and won't participate in Q2

Last 5 cars will start the race based on their qualifying results (From P16 up to P20)

Q2

Remaining 15 cars leave the garages

At the end of the session TOP 10 drivers proceed to Q3

LAST 5 cars are deemed to PARC FERME and won't participate in Q3

Last 5 cars will start the race based on their qualifying results (From P11 up to P15)

Q3

Remaining 10 cars leave the garages

At the end of the session all drivers get their starting positions based on lap times

TOP 10 cars are stopped at scrutineering platform and will be released to team garages after Platform Inspection

Parc Ferme Definition

Literal meaning “Closed Park”

This condition indicates that the car is in closed park conditions. No changes/modifications can be made except the ones that allowed or granted special permission from FIA

Parc Ferme Locations

Under the podium: cars are parked under podium during/after Qualifying and Races

Only 3 team mechanics are allowed near the car at the same time

Once cars are released to the team during/after Qualifying, they are pushed to their garages. Each Scrutineer must follow assigned car

What to do?

During Parc Ferme each scrutineer writes down all car related changes/processes on GREEN CHECKLISTS

You start to use green list once your car completes qualifying



F1 Sunday Schedule

Parc Ferme

Scrutineers arrive at designated garage in 5 hours prior to the start of Formation lap

Cars will be unsealed by FIA

If any car related changes/processes took place - write down on GREEN check lists

Grid checks

Cars will leave to the grid and grid checks will be carried out on the starting grid

Post Race checks

All the cars will undergo post race inspection at Scrutineering platform

F1 LIFT TEAM: 3 people will be required for F1 Lift Team. The cars are scanned by laser machines.



FORMULA 2 SCHEDULE

Initial Scrutineering

WHY?

To make sure that all cars and equipment are in compliance with FIA safety regulations

WHO?

YOU must check both the car and driver's safety gear

SO?

In case of any incompliance team must sort it out immediately

Cars are not allowed to race if they fail to pass your inspection
